#### **Medicines**

## **Spending Money**

A suggested minimum is 20 € with an absolute maximum of 40 €. Children will not be allowed to spend in excess of this. Please provide notes of NO larger than 5 €

No English currency should be taken.

Spending money should be in 2 named purses/wallets.

The purses should be packed in their case, please make sure the children know where they are. The staff will take these from the children and give them spending money daily.
